### HBMS Select Chorus 2018-2019



Thank you for your interest in Hawthorne Brook's Select Chorus for 2018-2019. The Select Chorus is an auditioned chorus that runs from the first week of December to the first week of April. Rehearsals and concerts do not conflict with band or the spring play. We will rehearse on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:30 - 4:30 in preparation for a concert at HBMS and the MICCA festival the first week of April.

Select Chorus is new for this year. So what is Select Chorus?

- **Select Chorus will make you a better singer.** We will learn so much vocal technique that you will be amazed how much better you can sing in April than you do now. Even if you are a really good singer already.
- Select Chorus will make you a better musician. I played in band before I joined chorus. Band helped me read music really wonderfully, but I learned how to be a musician in chorus. Chorus taught me how to create a beautiful phrase, and what I needed to do to take notes on the page and make music from it.
- Select Chorus will expand what you think your voice can do. Your range will expand. You will be able to create beautiful vocal harmonies.
- Select Chorus is challenging. Most people can sing along with a recording. But creating pure sounding vowel, clear diction, complex harmonies take focus and hard work. You will be amazed at what we can do with our voices.
- Select Chorus is safe. It is filled with other students at HBMS that have a common goal to create beautiful music. In Chorus, you are never alone. Even if you have a solo, the entire ensemble is there to support you. Chorus creates one sound with many voices.
- Select Chorus is friendship and memories. Some of my most cherished memories in school was in Chorus, Band, and the Musicals. We worked hard, but we also laughed and had fun. The students in those groups help guide me through school, and surrounded me with a safe and positive experience. I still hold on to those memories today.

#### **Songs:**

For MICCA, we have to prepare three songs. A good friend of mine (whose middle school chorus received a gold medal a few years ago, suggested a Folk Song, a song in Latin, and a Spiritual. Each will be able to showcase different aspects of singing technique and group blend. I have listened to literally hundreds of pieces and have narrowed it down to a few selections from each. Listen to them on the HBMS Select Chorus website and we will decide as a group at our first rehearsal. If we learned these three well, we could add some other songs for our HBMS concert.

#### **Commitment:**

At each rehearsal, we will work on technique and music. It is important that you are at every rehearsal that you are scheduled and are ready to work hard. It wastes others' time if we need to review something from previous rehearsals. We will have sectionals some days, so you will not be needed at every rehearsal listed below. On the sign-up sheet, please indicate what rehearsals you cannot attend, so I can adjust the schedule as needed.

#### **Auditions:**

Prepare a song selection 1 minute or less, to be sung acapella. Any song is ok, but I am looking to hear good tone quality and musicianship, so I suggest folk, classical or musicals. If you can't decide on a song, the national anthem is always great. You will also be required to sing a few warm-ups that I will teach you so I can hear your vocal range.
